TAKEN A REGULAR MEETING HELD, MONDAY,
 November 17, 2014
 5:30 p.m.

The Natchitoches Parish Council met in regular and legal session in the Council Board Room of the Natchitoches Parish Courthouse, on Monday, November 17, 2014 for regular Natchitoches Parish Council meeting at five-thirty (5:30) o'clock p.m.

The Parish of Natchitoches was then convened as the governing authority by Chairman Aaron Johnson who stated that the Parish was ready for the transaction of business.

The invocation was given by Reverend Steve Harris and the Pledge of Allegiance led by Chairman Aaron Johnson.

After the roll call there were present Chairman Aaron Johnson and Councilmen Rodney Bedgood, Ricky LaCour, Chris Paige, and John Salter.

There was absent: None.

Chairman Johnson then asked if there were any visitors who would like to speak and Mrs. Tina Matthews-McCart from our Natchitoches Parish Head Start and other employees from the Head Start Program wanted to address that their monthly paychecks were reduced by 4% and they wanted their money to be returned back to them because they expressed that they work hard for their money. The Head Start employees expressed over a nine month period this amount is significant to each of them and they think its unfair to reduce their pay this way. The employees expressed also that they are funded by the federal government, scheduled pay raises are only given when the federal government allows a cost of living raise(COLA).

Parish President Rick Nowlin addressed the issue and then Parish Treasurer Debbie Miley also stated that the Head Start Child Food Grant Budget would have to be approved anyway that night and that we needed to amend the agenda to add it on it. Parish Treasurer, Debbie Miley had a Budget that included no increase in wages and a Budget that includes 2.00% increase in wages.

1. Payne Subdivision

3. Goldonna Road
4. Fish Hatchery Road
5. Blanchard

Councilman Chris Paige spoke that he feels that the residents in Payne Subdivision has been waiting for three(3) to four(4)years waiting on their streets to be repaired. And he hope they can consider putting Payne Subdivision first on the priority list. Councilman Bedgood, stated he have been waiting even longer for some of his roads, but they need to choose a road and get that road completed and move on to another road. He feels that they need to make a decision to begin one project at a time getting it completed and beginning on a new one before we loose everything.

Chairman Johnson then recognized Mr. Nick Verret, Director of Public Works, who presented his reports.

The mechanical pothole patcher is still awaiting the receipt of parts from an out-of-state vendor for its repair, which was shipped on November 6.

Davis Surveying was retained to provide a survey of a 1-acre tract at the intersection of LA-117 and LA-478 for enclosure of the bin site there, following which the Parish will acquire this tract from Hancock Land Management at a cost of \$2,500.

Coco Bed Road is still awaiting execution of the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Office of Facility Planning and Control before design work can begin.

Surplus Equipment Auction the Parish received a total of \$24,636 from the sale of surplus equipment through Lasyone's Auctions on October 18. Of this total, \$1,000 will be credited to the Government Buildings fund from the sale of the propane tank at the Courthouse and the remainder will go to the Highway fund.

Chairman Johnson then recognized Ms. Sharon Harris OCS/Head Start Executive Director. Ms. Harris went over her report discussing LIHEAP which the program assisted 62 households for the month of October which totaled \$23,150.00. And at this time the program has ran out of funds.

Food for Seniors which provided 40-pound box to individuals 60 years. November 20, 2014 is the distribution date.

The Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) Provided rental and/or utility deposit assistance-one(1) household enrolled for \$480.30 Provided clothing assistance for 5 individuals.

Commodity provided Services for the month of September were 142 households. Distribution is for November 20, 2014.

Chairman Johnson then recognizes Ms. Debbie Miley, Parish Treasurer, Ms. Miley then went on to discuss her reports giving status updates on the 2014 Active Bookings for Inmates & Outstanding Coroners/Inmate Expenses.

She asked the Council if they had any questions for her and there was none.

Chairman Johnson then recognized Parish President Rick Nowlin he gave an update on:

CAPITAL OUTLAY:

The State Bond Commission approved the following project recommendations made by the Governor's Office at its meeting on October 16, 2014:

1. Coco Bed Road Improvements: \$180,000 P2 Cash. (In addition to \$100,000 previously approved)

status: An amendment to the CEA for the project is being prepared, bringing the total State funding to \$280,000.

2. Courthouse Security Improvements: \$30,000 P2 Cash and \$380,000 P5 Non Cash. Status: **We are waiting on the CEA from the state.**

3. Old River Bridge: \$85,000 P2 Cash. (In addition to \$535,000 previously approved)

status: The Parish is unable to proceed at this time due to the lack of sufficient state funding to complete the project and the required local match amount. A new FY 2015-2016 application has been submitted for the remaining funds required for the project.

FIRE DISTRICTS:

Mr. Hulen Clark, Chairman of the board of Fire District 4 has informed us that the district rating has been reduced to a rating of 5.

PERSONNEL:

Mr. Karl Sowell, a Parish employee, raised a question at a recent Council meeting in regard to the withdrawal of funds from his retirement account without his knowledge or authorization. The paperwork has come back from Parochial Employee's Retirement System office in Baton Rouge providing documentation indicated that Mr. Sowell signed the release forms and endorsed the checks received from the system. Based on upon the information provided by PERS, it appears that Mr. Sowell requested the funds in question. If he feels that someone has fraudulent signed his name to the papers he could contact the sheriff's office for further investigation and action.

Mr. Donald Charles, a Parish employee, raised a question at a recent Council meeting in regard to the Parish's attempt to ascertain any physical limitations he may have. The purpose of the Parish efforts was to identify what limitations existed, if any, and to incorporate reasonable adjustments to Mr. Charles' work assignment in order to reduce the probability of any injury to Mr. Charles. Mr. Charles should not undertake any physical activity that would cause him any injury and any tasks not performed by Mr. Charles at the Health Unit will be performed by courthouse maintenance staff.

Mrs. Cathy Creamer, Account Clerk II, has been appointed EEO officer for the Parish, effective November 17, 2014. Mrs. Creamer presently handles employee compensation and benefits programs and this additional role is a natural extension of her duties.

HEAD START:

- a. On September 4, 2014, we received a Notice of Deficiency from the LA Department of Environmental Quality for failing to have an Asbestos Management Plan (AMP) at the Head Start center at 415 MLK Drive. After searching Head Start and Parish Files and not finding any AMP, we contacted the Natchitoches Parish School Board. When the school board was not able to assist us, the Parish Council authorized a contract with CEC for the preparation of the AMP. CEC began its work on November 12th and it is estimated that the Parish should receive CEC's report within four (4) to six (6) weeks. LA DEQ has been notified of the status of our efforts to comply with its regulations.

EL CAMINO REAL CORRIDOR:

Mr. James W. Scarborough and the Parish President attended the El Camino meeting in Winnfield on October 22, 2014. During the meeting, the President was elected president of the commission and Mr. Scarborough was re-elected secretary-treasurer.

President has worked with DOTD in the filing of a FY2015-2016 Capital Outlay Application that includes the El Camino projects in Natchitoches, Winn and LaSalle Parishes. The total amount of the application over five (5) years is in excess of \$159,000,000.

Parish President also gave a list of his Recent events and his upcoming events.
