

PROCEEDINGS OF THE NATCHITOCHE PARISH COUNCIL
PARISH OF NATCHITOCHE, STATE OF LOUISIANA
TAKEN A REGULAR MEETING HELD, MONDAY,
APRIL 27, 2015
5:30 p.m.

The Natchitoches Parish Council met in regular and legal session in the Council Board Room of the Natchitoches Parish Courthouse, on Monday, March 16, 2015 for regular Natchitoches Parish Council meeting at five-thirty (5:30) o'clock p.m.

The Parish of Natchitoches was then convened as the governing authority by Chairman John Salter who stated that the Parish was ready for the transaction of business.

The invocation was given by Mr. Robert Weaver and the Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilman Ricky LaCour. After the roll call there were present Chairman John Salter and Councilmen Chris Paige, Rodney Bedgood, Ricky LaCour and Aaron Johnson.

There was absent: None.

Chairman Salter then asked if there were any visitors who would like to speak. Mr. David Adams from Edward Adams Road spoke on behalf of the residents from the North End of the Parish close to the Red River Parish line. He wants to know what the Parish is going to do about the road situation and the Infrastructure of the Parish. He needs to know a plan. Mr. Adams says he doesn't mind paying taxes if the money is going to be spent on the roads and not people salaries. He also stated that the mail and newspaper services is being affected by the roads. Mr. David Adams stated he need the road situation addressed.

After, Mr. David Adams had spoken, Chairman John Salter asked Mr. Nick Verret if at this time would be the best time to present his presentation and after the presentation is finished then Mr. Verret would answer any and all questions, but he feels his presentation will answer many of the unanswered questions that residents have.

Mr. Verret began his presentation on the Overview of the Parish System, Organization Structure, Current Status, Budget, and Long Term Plans will be covered by Parish President, Rick Nowlin. Mr. Nick Verret began with a background of his education, qualifications, and job experience.

Mr. Verret stated there is 818 miles of road in the Parish road system and 977 Individual road sections. 326 miles of paved roads and 492 miles of unpaved roads. 90% of the paved roads are in terrible condition and there are 75 Bridges in our system also.

Mr. Verret also stated when he came aboard he also implemented a customer service tracking system and a Budget tracking system, these are the most important services to have and to keep track of calls, complaints and what the money is being spent on and what is needed to purchased this will provide a "real-time" tracking of expenditures versus budgeted amount for each line item, enabling adjustments to stay within overall budgeted amount for department. Mr. Verret wanted the residents to know that the Highway department is operating off 5 permanent motor graders, 3 Tandem Dump Trucks due to equipment breakdown on only 19 days this year and 2 available on only 29 days this year out of 37 workdays on which material was hauled (thru 4/9/15), 1 Bobtail Truck and Mini Excavator, Tractor Trailer, Track hoe, and additional leased mini-excavator, Mechanical Pothole patcher and it's only ran for 1 day since August 2014 and 1 in house and 1 inmate Cold Mix Patching Crew, and Contract Trucks have been utilized when available .

Mr. Verret stated he was "Putting out Fires" addressing the most critical road issues as they arise(Citizen requests and issues found

by Parish Staff) He was only doing "light" spot grading between rains to remove potholing and ruts and adding maintenance rock as needed and pothole patching. Work is scheduled on basis of severity and extent of road issues and number of citizens affected, as well as availability of equipment and material. Mr. Verret wanted the residents to also know this is not an exact science and it requires constant tweaking, sometimes several times daily and this often results in moving crews to other roads before completing the one they're on.

In summary of Mr. Verret he stated that 83% of budget amount of Winn Rock has been placed, 24% of budgeted amount of Black Rock has been placed, 31% of budgeted amount of Washed Gravel has been placed and 15% of Cold Mix has been placed and 344 roads have received some type of work since January 1, 2015.

Routine grading will begin as soon as conditions allow and Ditching with grades and mini-excavators will be done on key roads, and Rock and tar patching with mechanical pothole patcher to supplement cold-mix patching, Demonstration project to scarify selected badly deteriorated paved roads and add reclaimed asphalt pavement (RAP) obtained through special donation from LA DOTD, and trail use of alternate repair materials, as budget allows.

Hot-mix Asphalt patching and leveling on Kisatchie-Mora Road with U.S. Forest Service earmarked funds (\$154,000)

Mr. Nowlin stated with Long Term Plan the Parish will continue maintenance activities and develop new sources of funding for the Parish Hwy Dept. without new taxes.

When the presentation was completed Jackie Myles from 145 Sisson Loop, stated he began this process since December and he wanted to know from Rick Nowlin when was the last time he has traveled down Sisson Loop, and Mr. Nowlin stated not since the last time Mr. Myles came to last month meeting. Mr. Myles continued to asked why haven't his roads been completed they started and they didn't come back, Mr. Verret stated he went over that in the presentation they are only "putting out fires" right now, Mr. Myles was not satisfied with this, he said he was not going to tear up his car on those roads, something has to be done.

John McAlphin, stated he feels that the Ad Hoc Advisory Commission on Parish roads is good, but he feels more parish residents needs to be involved on this Commission. He thinks this will be a fair representation of the Parish.

Mr. Robert Weaver, Collins road resident wanted to know why would a truck not be repaired or maintenance in a year's time? and Why are we not using inmates for road work? Mr. Weaver expressed the Parish is paying \$15.50 a day for inmates why can't we use them for man power. The Parish pays between \$50,000 thru \$70,000 a month for inmates, why can't we use them?

Mr. Verret stated the parts that was needed had to come from up North and then the operator found another job. As for as inmates they had to used what was given and then the inmates have to be supervised by officers at all times. He doesn't know the criteria of how the inmates are selected to work he only use what is given.

Mr. Cliff Hart, Robeline resident wanted to know if Mr. Verret has used up 83% of the budget on rocks what is he going to do later on. Why would you used rocks on months that are wet instead of using them during the dry period. Chairman Salter stated that this was only for Winn Rock budget not the whole budget. Mr. Verret agreed on Chairman Salter answer to this question.

Mr. Juddy Hammous, Albritton resident, Mr. Hammous, stated all the complaining and gripping needs to stop and everyone needs to roll up their sleeves and get to job done. His main focus is keeping everyone safe. He stated, he haven't complain about the conditions of the roads, he know they are bad, but he has called Steve Rachal at the Highway Department about the road issue in his area and no one has come out to check on the road or fix it. Mr. Hammous stated parish roads are traveled by many. He wants to know what is the answer to this problem. How is this problem going to be solved? Mr. Hammous, stated he has lived in the country setting for 50 years and he loves it, but something has to be done on the roads.

Mr. Randy Stelly from the Real View he travels the parish roads from DeSoto, Red River in a Ford Escape he hits holes that throws the papers from the back to the front of his vehicle, but the biggest problem is money. He stated he fought for the new form of Government and this new Government have balance the budget this year, something that has not been done in 15 to 20 years. Maybe the budget being balance is not helping the road problems, but it's balanced. He feels that if the Parish gets the money straight then residents would pay taxes to get the roads fixed.

Sherry Wren, resident of Pardee road/ Hart road, she drives a school bus and the roads are in bad shape. If everyone is saying they need money to fix roads, then how is this going to be address. Five Forks going to the mines are in bad shape also.

Cletis Self, Hart/Pardee road resident, culvert is stopped up and they need this culvert fixed so the water will drain off the roads. Curtis Rachal Road, is the road the Culvert needs to be fixed on, this will help the residents with the water problem covering the road.

Councilman Rodney Bedgood, showed pictures of roads he travel on a daily basis. He's a mail carrier and travel to his home, the roads are terrible and he stated he gets calls, telling him he doesn't know, but he states he does know, but he don't know the answer on how its going to be fixed. He reports it to the Highway department when everyone calls him. He stated he can't control how the highway department is fixing the roads. He stated he gets paid \$470.00 month and if anyone wants to the job he welcome them to run. He's not in it for the money he in it to try to make a difference. His area covers Ashland/Campti/Fairview Alpha/Readheimer/Goldonna/Black Lake/Clear Lake, Moose Lodge, Sibley Lake, Oak Grove, Edge of Marthaville, Valley Electric Area to Hwy 1, just to name a few.

Judy Webster, Provencal resident, she works for the State for 30 thirty years and wanted to know if the Parish would consider looking at other aspects of grant money to help with road work. There is grant money out there and they need to explore that avenue.

Pat Todd, states he travels the roads in the north area of the Parish. He stated the Johnson Chute Road has gravel and some paved parts, this road has deteriorated over the years many years ago you could go about 80 miles per hour down it, but not now try it. Mr. Todd expressed all roads that are State, City or Parish are in bad shape. Pat Todd stated he trust this form of Parish Government and what they're trying to accomplished. We do need to do something, and Mr. Pat Todd believes, Director of Public Works, Nick Verret, is doing a good job, and if a tax need to be passed he would support it from this form of Government.

Mary Ann Miller, Robeline resident, stated each person has a different view and opinion on the road matter, but everyone should be working for a solution to fixing our Parish roads.

John Hodgeson, a resident from Campti, stated if the Parish would do as he requested at last month meeting that each resident be taxed \$5.00 a year for each property they own we can get money to fix roads.

There were no other public comments.
